REPORT OF ALUMNI MEET HELD ON 26TH JANUARY 2020

Alumni Meet was held on the 26th January 2020 at our Periyar Arts College, Cuddalore. Committee of Faculty members were appointed to conduct this meet. Students of previous batches were informed about the meet through different media. Each alumnus who was present for the said meet were warmly invited and asked with their present status and also about their memories at their time of study in the college. The present status of the college is well informed to Alumni and they were asked for suggestions to develop the College.

Alumni Feedback were asked to indicate their level of satisfaction with the fifteen statements accordingly for which they have to choose a score between 0 and 4 (4 – Strongly Agree, 3 – Agree, 2 – Not Sure, 1 – Disagree, 0 – Strongly Disagree). All the statements are compulsory. No time limit is specified for the completion of the Feedback, but appropriate time is given to complete the same. Instead the list of fifteen statements, the Name, Year of Study (Batch), Degree: Mobile Number and Current Position and Company Name were asked. (Alumni Feedback was appended in Appendix)

A total of 177 Alumni responded the questionnaire and indicate their level of satisfaction as per the given directions. Using the obtained general information, the distribution of Alumni was made as in the following table:

From the name given by the Alumni, it is found that there were 162 **Male** and 15 **Female** in the collection with respect to **Gender**. On the classification made with **Subject Studied**, there were 69 **Arts** and 108 **Science** Alumni. Since the earlier NAAC visited the college during the year 2013-14, two classifications were made on the **Year of Study** namely, **Before 2013-14** batch which has 144 Alumni and **2013-14 and After** has 33 numbers. With regard to the **Course Studied** by the Alumni, two classifications namely **Under-graduation** Course and **Post-graduation** Course, and 159 Alumni studied Under-graduation and 18 studied Post-graduation Courses.

The obtained responses of the fifteen statements on the Levels of Satisfaction were analyzed on the basis of three parts: (1) On the basis of responses of each statement by the Alumni, (2) On the basis of total scores obtained and (3) On the basis of certain Criterion of Alumni feedback.

PART-1: ANALYSIS OF RESPONSES OF EACH STATEMENT BY THE ALUMNI

Each statement is responded with five alternatives, namely Strongly Agree, Agree, Not Sure, Disagree and Strongly Disagree. The total response of each statement of all the Alumni is tabulated as below:

The responses obtained for each option in the Alumni Feedback shows that the Alumni Strongly Agrees for the statements in the Alumni Feedback Form. *Alumni show favourable attitude towards these statements and indicates a high level satisfaction in all aspects.*

PART-2: ANALYSIS OF TOTAL SCORES OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK

With regard to the responses given by the Alumni towards the fifteen statements is discussed in the total scores. Using the obtained responses, the following Report was made:

The Mean and the Standard Deviation on the *Levels of Satisfaction* of the Alumni (N= 177) is found to be 49.22 and 9.88 respectively. The Median is obtained as 51.00 and there are 10 Alumni with the same Level of Satisfaction scores. There are 84 Alumni with Level of Satisfaction scores below median and 83 Alumni with scores above median. The Level of Satisfaction scores of the Alumni (N= 177) is obtained in the range of 0 to 60 and it is also the actual range. The obtained mean of Levels of Satisfaction scores (M = 49.22) of the Alumni is above the scale average (Scale average = 30.00). The Level of Satisfaction of the Alumni is found as 82.03%. It is concluded that the *Levels of Satisfaction of the Alumni is high*.

PART-3: ANALYSIS OF SCORES ON CERTAIN CRITERION OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK

With regard to the responses given by the Alumni towards the fifteen statements is discussed also in four criteria namely, College, Teacher Student Support and Curriculum. These fifteen statements are classified on the basis of its content, as above mentioned criterions.

The Mean and the Standard Deviation on the *Levels of Satisfaction on the College Criteria* of the Alumni (N= 177) is found to be 16.96 and 3.27 respectively. The Median is obtained as 18.00 and there are 29 Alumni with the same Level of Satisfaction scores on the College Criteria. There are 80 Alumni with Level of Satisfaction scores on the College Criteria below median and 68 Alumni with scores above median. The Level of Satisfaction scores on the College Criteria of the Alumni (N= 177) is obtained in the range of 0 to 20 and it is also the actual range. The obtained mean of Levels of Satisfaction scores on the College Criteria (M = 16.96) of the Alumni is above the scale average (Scale average = 10.00). The Level of Satisfaction on the College Criteria of the Alumni is found as 84.80%. It is concluded that the Alumni shows a **high level of (above 70%) Satisfaction on the College Criteria of the Alumni is.**

The Mean and the Standard Deviation on the *Levels of Satisfaction on the Teacher Criteria* of the Alumni (N= 177) is found to be 13.33 and 2.86 respectively. The Median is obtained as 14.00 and there are 22 Alumni with the same Level of Satisfaction scores on the Teacher Criteria. There are 82 Alumni with Level of Satisfaction scores on the Teacher Criteria below median and 73 Alumni with scores above median. The Level of Satisfaction scores on the Teacher Criteria of the Alumni (N= 177) is obtained in the range of 0 to 16 and it is also the actual range. The obtained mean of Levels of Satisfaction scores on the Teacher Criteria (M = 13.33) of the Alumni is above the scale average (Scale average = 8.00). The Level of Satisfaction on the Teacher Criteria of the Alumni is found as 83.31%. It is concluded that there is a **high level of Satisfaction on the Teacher Criteria.**

The Mean and the Standard Deviation on the *Levels of Satisfaction on the Student Support Criteria* of the Alumni (N= 177) is found to be 12.66 and 2.98 respectively. The Median is obtained as 13.00 and there are 18 Alumni with the same Level of Satisfaction scores on the Student Support Criteria. There are 82 Alumni with Level of Satisfaction scores on the Student Support Criteria below median and 77 Alumni with scores above median. The Level of Satisfaction scores on the Student Support Criteria of the Alumni (N= 177) is obtained in the range of 0 to 16 and it is also the actual range. The obtained mean of Levels of Satisfaction scores on the Student Support Criteria (M = 12.66) of the Alumni is above the scale average (Scale average = 8.00). The Level of Satisfaction on the Student Support Criteria of the Alumni is found as 79.13%. It is

concluded that the *Levels of Satisfaction on the Student Support Criteria of the Alumni is in high level.*

The Mean and the Standard Deviation on the *Levels of Satisfaction on the Curriculum Criteria* of the Alumni (N= 177) is found to be 6.37 and 1.57 respectively. The Median is obtained as 7.00 and there are 36 Alumni with the same Level of Satisfaction scores on the Curriculum Criteria. There are 86 Alumni with Level of Satisfaction scores on the Curriculum Criteria below median and 55 Alumni with scores above median. The Level of Satisfaction scores on the Curriculum Criteria of the Alumni (N= 177) is obtained in the range of 0 to 8 and it is also the actual range. The obtained mean of Levels of Satisfaction scores on the Curriculum Criteria (M = 6.37) of the Alumni is above the scale average (Scale average = 4.00). The Level of Satisfaction on the Curriculum Criteria of the Alumni is found as 79.63%. It is concluded that the *Level of Satisfaction on the Curriculum Criteria of the Alumni is also high.*
