#### 1. TOOL USED

**Parents' Feedback on Curriculum** was asked to indicate their level of satisfaction with the fifteen statements accordingly for which they have to choose a score between 0 and 4 (4 – Strongly Agree, 3 – Agree, 2 – Not Sure, 1 – Disagree, 0 – Strongly Disagree). All the statements are compulsory. No time limit is specified for the completion of the Feedback, but appropriate time is given to complete the same. Instead the list of fifteen statements, the Name of the Parent, Name of the Student, Year of Study (Batch), Degree and Mobile Number were asked. (Parents' Feedback on Curriculum was appended in Appendix)

#### 2. SAMPLE SELECTION

Twenty courses that are run by the College were taken irrespective of the morning and evening shifts and English or Tamil as medium of instruction. This includes fourteen Undergraduate and Post-graduate Courses (namely, Tamil, English, Economics, Commerce, History, Public Administration, Political Science, Computer Science, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology, Botany and Statistics), five Undergraduate Courses (namely, Business Administration, Psychology, Computer Applications, Microbiology and Visual Communication) and Only one Postgraduate Master of Social Work Course.

Two major disciplines were classified with these twenty courses namely, ARTS and SCIENCE. *Discipline of Arts* includes nine courses namely, Tamil, English, Economics, Commerce, History, Public Administration, Business Administration, Political Science and Social Work. *Discipline of Science* includes eleven courses namely, Computer Science, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology, Botany, Statistics, Psychology, Computer Applications, Microbiology and Visual communication.

Parents of Students Sample of these courses were taken from each year of study. Undergraduate Courses were classified with the present first, second and third years, but Postgraduate Courses were combined with first and second years. Hence, 46 Courses were identified. The Distribution of Year-wise Disciplines of Courses with the selected number of parents of students was given in the following table.

The highest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2019-2022 batch) Undergraduate Public Administration and Political Science Course Students and the lowest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2019-2022 batch) Undergraduate English Course Students. This shows that the parents of third year undergraduate students of Public Administration and Political Science are more satisfied and the parents of English are less satisfied towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.

The total Percentage Index (80.68) of the 27 parents of third year (2019-2022 Batch) Undergraduate Arts Students from four courses shows a favourable attitude towards these statements and indicates a high level satisfaction towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.

The highest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2019-2022 batch) Undergraduate Mathematics, Zoology, Botany, Statistics, Psychology and Computer Applications Course Students and the lowest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2019-2022 batch) Undergraduate Microbiology Course Students. *This shows that the parents of third year undergraduate students of* Mathematics, Zoology, Botany, Statistics, Psychology and Computer Applications *are more satisfied and the parents of Visual communication are less satisfied towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.* 

The total Percentage Index (81.24) of the 31 parents of third year (2019-2022 Batch) Undergraduate Science Students from eight courses shows a favourable attitude towards these

statements and indicates a high level satisfaction towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.

The highest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of second year (2020-2023 batch) Undergraduate History and Political Science Course Students and the lowest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of second year (2020-2023 batch) Undergraduate Commerce Course Students.
